THE YALTA CONFERENCE

- Meeting at the end of WWII
- USSR gets Eastern Europe
- Germany/Berlin divided
- USSR never gives it back



THE MARSHALL PLAN

- Europe destroyed by WWII
- \$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$ to rebuild!
- US Sec. of State Marshall...
- Soviet Satellites refused...



THE IRON CURTAIN

- Europe divided after WWII
- West=Democracy/Capitalist
- Ideological Division
- East=Dictatorship/Commun.

THE TRUMAN DOCTRINE/CONTAINMENT

- Formerly Monroe Doctrine
- GOAL: Keep Communism
- Pearl Harbor changed USA within its current borders

THE DOMINO THEORY

- If one nation falls to Communism... the next will.

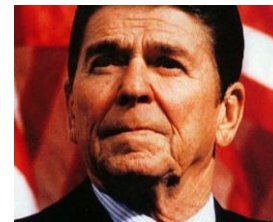

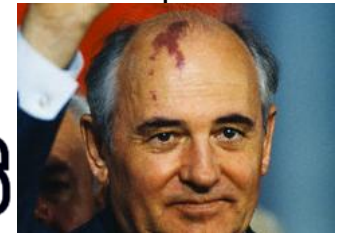

FALL OF THE QING DYNASTY

- DYNASTIES RULED CHINA FOR 4000 YEARS
- LAST ONE (QING) OVERTHROWN IN 1911
- LED TO YEARS OF RULE BY WARLORDS
- EVENTUALLY RULED BY NATIONALIST CHIANG KAI-SHEK

- KOREA IS DIVIDED:
- AT THE 38th PARALLEL
 - **NORTH:** USSR SUPPORTED
 - **SOUTH:** USA SUPPORTED

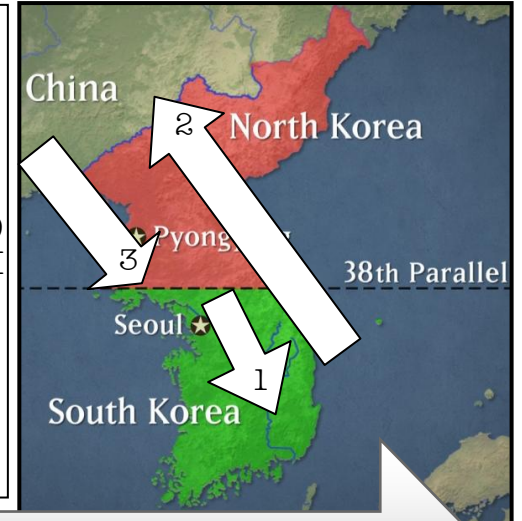

1961 BERLIN WALL 1989

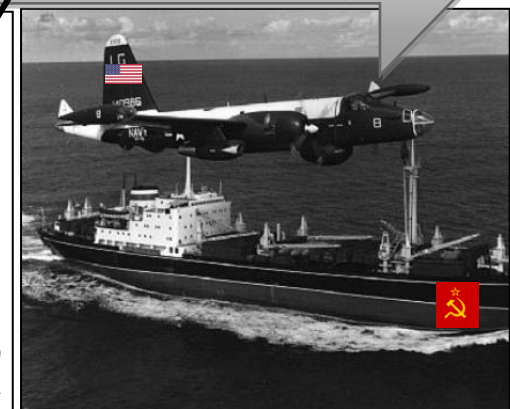
- LARGE TOWERS/CONCRETE WALLS
- ACCORDING TO THE COMMUNISTS:
 - BUILT TO PROTECT FROM FASCISTS
- ACCORDING TO REALITY:
 - BUILT TO STOP ALL OF THE EAST BERLINERS FROM EMIGRATING (or FLEEING TO WEST BERLIN)
 - BUILT TO STOP THE "BRAIN DRAIN"

1962 CUBAN MISSILE CRISIS 1962

- CUBA BECOMES COMMUNIST IN 1959
- OCTOBER 14, 1962: PHOTO TAKEN
 - JFK WARNS THIS IS UNACCEPTABLE
 - CHOICES:
 - NAVAL BLOCKADE
 - ATTACK THE MISSILES
 - DEAL BROKERED
 - USSR removes their missiles
 - USA removes our missiles (Turkey)
- CLOSEST THE WORLD CAME TO NUCLEAR WAR

VIETNAM WAS A FRENCH COLONY

- Since the 1800s

CONQUERED BY JAPAN IN WWII

PEACE CONFERENCE DIVIDES VIET

- At the 17th PARALLEL

HO CHI MINH FIGHTS FOR UNIFICATION

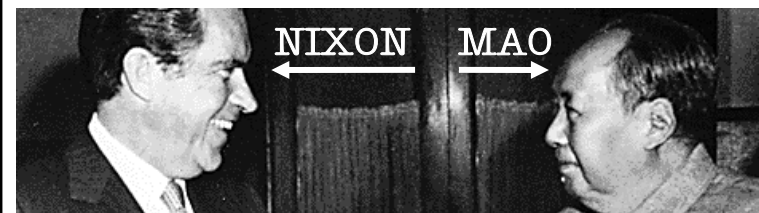
- Starts revolution in S. Vietnam

- Two problems for America...

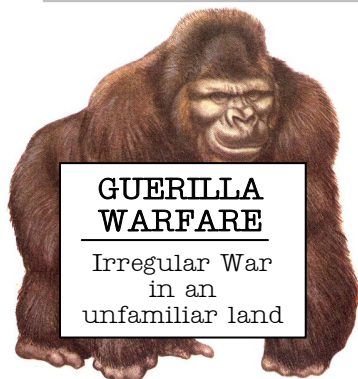

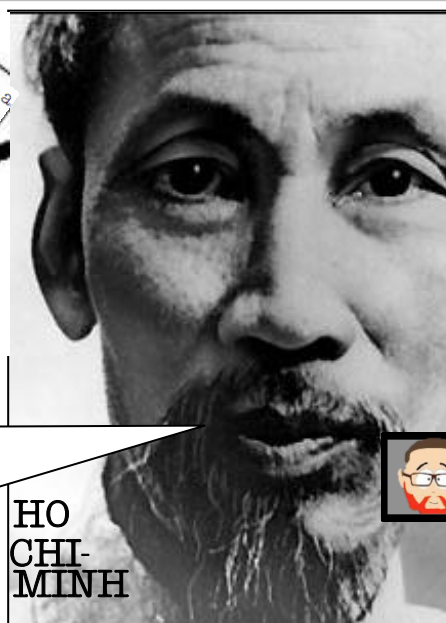

DÉTENTE=RELAXATION OF TENSIONS

- World almost ended several times...
- Both USA & USSR agreed to back off

MARKED BY TREATIES

- USSR to grant free elections in Europe
- Installation of a direct line to Moscow
- Ended with USSR invasion of Afghan.
 - US boycotted 1980 Moscow Olympics

NEIGHBORING COUNTRIES BEGAN OPENING THEIR BORDERS

- East Germans began to flee into Hungary, Austria, Czech
- Led to Protests in East Germany to bring end the wall
- East Berliners began gathering at the Wall's Checkpoints
 - “*Wir wollen raus!*” (We Want Out!)

1989 FALL of the BERLIN WALL 1989

“This is a historic day. East Germany has announced that, starting immediately, its borders are open to everyone. E. Germany is opening its borders ... the gates in the Berlin Wall stand open...”

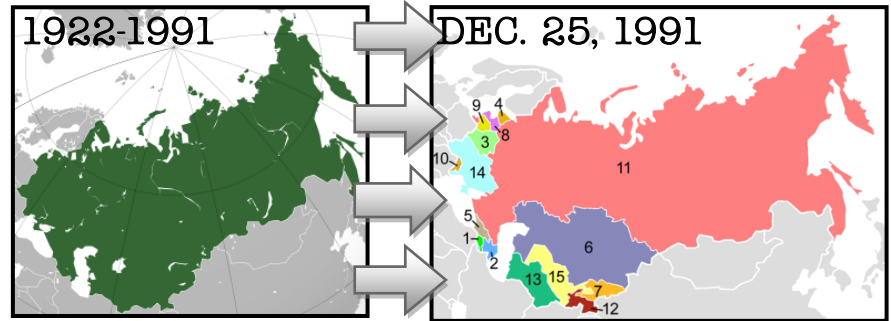
-West German News Broadcast, Nov. 9, 1989

- People outnumbered the guards
- 10:45 E. German Guards allowed free access...
- Celebrations ensued

NOVEMBER 9, 1989



"Irgendwann fällt jede Mauer" = "Eventually every wall falls"



SOVIET COMMUNIST ECONOMY WAS STAGNANT

- Mikhail Gorbachev instituted two new policies:
 - **PERESTROIKA** (Restructuring)
 - Transition from Communism to Socialism
 - Some small-scale Capitalism allowed
 - **GLASNOST** (Openness)
 - Freedoms of Press, Speech, Assembly

1991 COLLAPSE of the USSR 1991

SOVIET ALLIES HAD BEEN OUSTED IN E. EUROPE

- Led to Gorbachev instituting reforms
 - Open Churches that were closed for decades
 - Freed political prisoners
 - Published Banned books
- These actions upset the Communist Party
 - Attempted a Coup to overthrow Gorbachev
 - Failed; Stopped by Mass Protests

COLD WAR=OVER

- Leader of protests elected President
 - Boris Yeltsin
- USSR lost **HALF** of its population
- Economic Calamity
 - Standard of Living fell
 - Worse than G. Depr

The following world leaders shaped the Cold War during the end of the Cold War era (1945-1991). Their policies guided the world's most powerful nations into their current state today in the 21st Century.

GANDHI

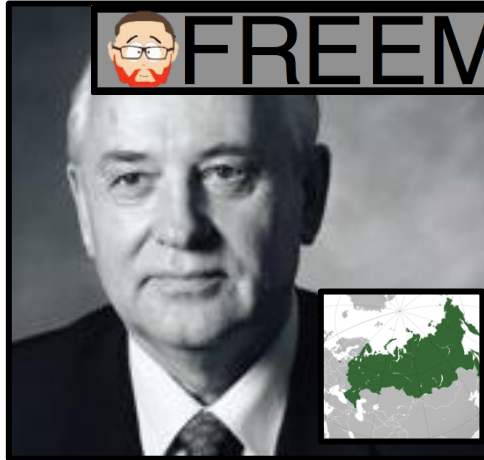
(1966-1977; 1980-1984)

- BORN IN 1917
- 3rd Prime Minister of India

MAJOR POLICIES

- 1st Female leader of the World's largest Democracy
- Father was the 1st Prime Min.
- Leaned on USSR for support
- Operation *Smiling Buddha*
 - 1967: Successful Nuclear test
- Ruled under 'State of Emergen.'
- Absolute rule from 75-77
- Increased Grain Production
- Assassinated in 1984

MIKHAIL
GORBACHEV

(1985-1991)

- BORN IN 1931
- 8th and Final Premier of USSR

MAJOR POLICIES

- Represented Younger Generation of Russians
- Worked with President Reagan
- PERESTROIKA (Reconstruction)
 - Change to Democracy, Socialism, Initiative, Creativity
- GLASNOST (Openness)
 - Freedom of Speech, Press
 - Public Criticism of Gov't
- Oversaw Collapse of USSR
 - Independence of former states
- 1990= Nobel Peace Prize

MARGARET
THATCHER

(1979-1990)

- BORN IN 1925
- 71st Prime Minister of Britain

MAJOR POLICIES

- "Iron Lady"
- Strict opponent of Communism
- Conservative
- Economic Restructuring
 - Less Regulation
 - Less Government
 - Pro-Free Market/Laissez Faire
- Close ties to the United States
- Tripled UK's Nuclear Forces
- Led war in the Falklands
- 2nd Longest reigning PM ever!

Margaret Thatcher



DENG
XIAOPING

(1978-1992)

- BORN IN 1904
- 3rd Paramount Leader of China

MAJOR POLICIES

- Veteran of Chinese Civil War
- Reformed after Mao Zedong
- Changed from/to:
 - Communist Economy
 - Free Market Economy
- Opened China to foreign investment
- Raised the standard of living of hundreds of millions of Chinese
- Communist Party remains in control
- Resigned after Tiananmen Sq.

EARTH AFTER THE COLD WAR

The COLD WAR dominated most of the planet for nearly 50 years. So, with the fall of the Berlin Wall and the dissolution of the Soviet Union, what political blueprint would come to dominate the 21st Century?

"We are witnessing most profound social change. Whether in the East or the South, the West or the North, hundreds of millions of people, new nations and states, new public movements and ideologies have moved to the forefront of history. The idea of democratizing the entire world order has become a powerful socio-political force. At the same time, the scientific and technological revolution has turned many economic, food, energy, environmental, information and population problems, which only recently we treated as national or regional ones, into global problems...

For a new type of progress throughout the world to become a reality, everyone must change.

Tolerance is the alpha and omega of a *new world order*.

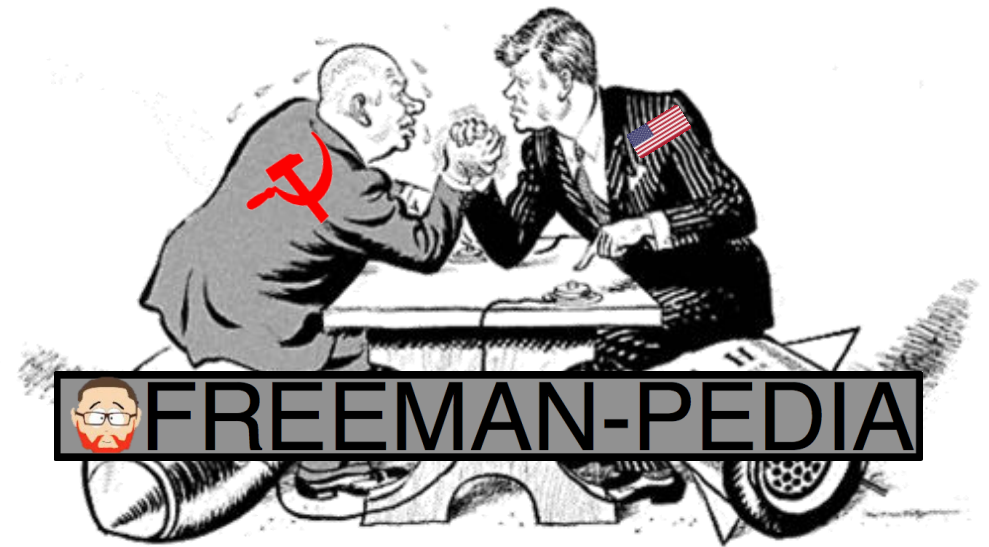

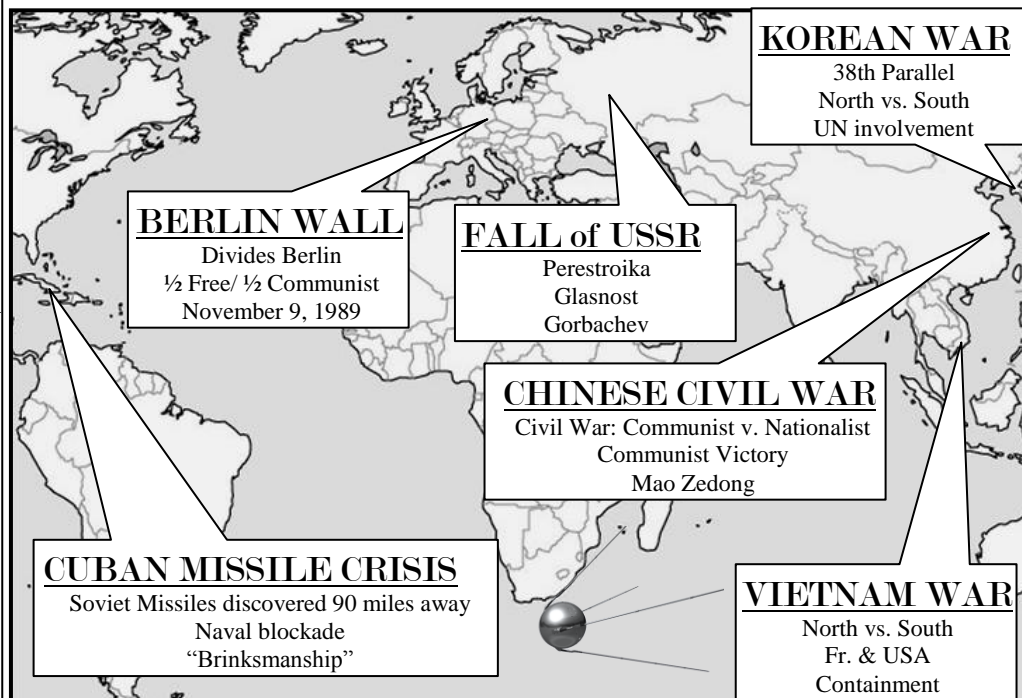
